













Proposed Unsheltered Action Lab Timeline

- The unique needs individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness and the following identities: BIPOC, LGBTQ+, individuals experiencing addition and/or mental health challenges.

These meetings will offer an opportunity to continue the conversation and do a deeper dive into the topics discussed with the full group.
